

Menhir Ty.

Joy and Simon Swindells hope you have a pleasant journey to France and look forward to seeing you at Meniry Ty.

From your point of entry into France, make your way to the city of **Rennes** and join the **Rocade** (outer ring road). As you will almost certainly be travelling from the north, join the Rocade in an anti-clockwise direction, i.e. going to your right. Keep your eyes open for signs to **Vannes and Lorient** via the **N24** and take this exit.



When you have joined the **N24**, continue for approximately **70km** (45 miles) to the town of **Josselin** and leave the dual carriageway at the signs for **Josselin Centre (D793)** which is directly opposite the supermarket **SuperU**.

At the bottom of the sliproad, you should **turn right** towards Lanouée (i.e. in the opposite direction to the supermarket and Josselin) and continue for around 3km (2 miles) to **Les Croix** where you should **turn left** and continue for a further **3km to Lanouée**.

Go through Lanouée keeping the church on your right.

Go **past the cemetery** on your right and take the **first road on the left** immediately at the end of the cemetery.

Take the **first lane on your right** and Menhir Ty is the **third drive on the right**.

If you have any difficulty in finding us, then please do not hesitate to telephone and we'll try to assist. However, if you are using a mobile phone, then do remember that you will be charged as if you are making an international call – even though you might be in France phoning a French number.

For your journey in Brittany, we recommend Michelin map *512 REGIONAL France* (ISBN 2-06-710569-8) which should be available from any good bookstore in the United Kingdom.
